Staffing Processing Guidelines will be sent via email to you mid February. Please ensure that you review this process if you plan to request a change in assignment.

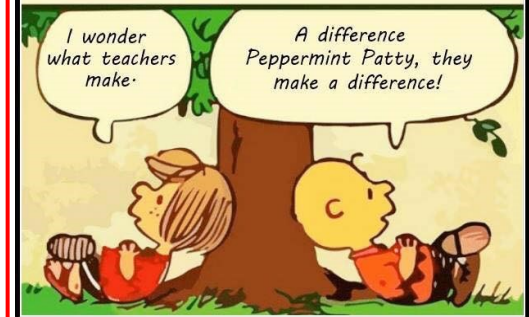
NOTE: Deadline for transfer or change in assignment from part-time to full-time or full-time to part-time is by application on Form A due **March 1st**.
